The Version 8.1 includes:

- Document your assessment notes in separate fields as strength, weaknesses and suggestion/improvements
- Notes are saved automatically, no worries that notes get lost
- Improved Benchmarking functionality to compare and analyse assessment results and determine which practices need a general improvement
- Improved Assessment Report with Evidence list export
- Deactivating Assessors, which are not any more active, assessments still include all their ratings and notes
- Set assessments to read-only in order to archive them
- Automatic generate your iNTACS log after the assessment
- Decreased load times drastically
- Many small bug fixes and improvements

The Capability Adviser is a web based team assessment tool, supporting Automotive SPICE(r) 3.1, VDA Guidelines, joint assessments, assessment reports and much more.



Create Assessment

In order to create an assessment a project has to exist and at least one assessor who will perform the assessment.

If a selection of processes are used in the assessment (e.g. VDA SCOPE) than a tailored domain has to be created, containing that set of processes




Insert/Edit a tailored domain

- Usually an assessment is not performed for all process in a PAM
- In order to create a tailored PAM, select Tailoring from the menu and Add
- Enter the Domain identification and description e.g.
 "VDA Automotive SPICE 3.1 Scope"

IMPORTANT


 Don't remove processes for tailored domains which were already assessed.





Create a Assessment

- Enter the Name and Description of the Assessment
- Add one or more assessors from the list of assessors
- Additional Information for the assessment such as purpose, period, sponsor etc. can be added by clicking o the Additional Information button
- Within the Administrator Interface, additional attributes for the assessment can be defined (e.g. OEM, Business Unit) and added






Edit an Assessment

- The name and description of the assessment can be changed without an impact on the assessment ratings
- Additional assessors can be added without impacting the existing assessment ratings
- Setting the assessment to Read only will disable the possibility to change or edit the rating and notes.

IMPORTANT

By removing assessors from the assessment, their ratings and notes will be also deleted!





Excel Import

- Assessments which have been exported using the Excel Export function in the Assessor View can be imported back.
- In order to import the excel rating and notes, the assessment, project, domain and assessor must exist with the exact same name in the database.
- The function is useful if notes are being refined after the assessment by assessor not having anymore access to the Capability Adviser

IMPORTANT


The existing ratings and notes are overwritten!





Import Assessment

- Assessments which have been exported using the Assessment Export function in the Assessor View can be imported back using the Import SQL function.
- The function creates a new project, assessment and adds assessors if missing
- After uploading the exported assessment, follow the instructions
- The function is useful if assessments were created using the offline or Raspberry solution and are now imported back to the main Capability Adviser server.





Assessment Report Template

- For the assessment report an own template can be used
- The template has to be saved in the .docx format
- In the template placeholders have to be set, which are in the tool replaced by real data
- In the template only the content is replaced, the formatting is not changed
- The assessment report template can be uploaded by selecting from the Utilities menu Change Template

Prepare Assessment Report Template

The template is filled with data using placeholders for the corresponding information. The following placeholders are used:

"{ASSESSMENT_TITLE}": Title of the assessment

"{PROJECT_NAME}" : Name of the project

"{ASSESSORS}": A list of all assessors in the assessment

"{CAP_LEVEL}": A table with the level achievements

"{CAP_ATTRIBUTES}": A table with the attribute satifactions

"{RATING}": A table with all rated elements

"{PERIOD}": The assessment period

"{SPONSOR}": The assessment sponsor

"{LOCAL COORDINATOR}": The local assessment coordinator

"{CLASS}": The assessment class

"{TYPE}": The assessment type

"{PROCESS_CONTEXT}": The process context

"{MODEL BASED DEV}": Is model based development used? (Yes/No)

"{AGILE}": Is it an agile environment? (Yes/No)

"{DISTRIBUTED_DEV}": Is there distributed development? (Yes/No)

"{THIRD PARTY}": Management of third party software? (Yes/No)

"{PLATFORM LEGACY}": Management of platform and legacy software? (Yes/No)

"{APP_PARAM}": Are there application parameters? (Yes/No)
